This Bibliography is not only a reading list for those who wish to dip into one or other aspect of the Bushmen or San. It is a source list for students and research workers who wish to follow up some phase of the numerous writings on the Bushmen and to probe the depths of it.

To make it easier to find one's way about the 290 titles in this list, they have been classified under a number of headings.

The first section deals with historical writings, most of which were published before 1910. These give a record of the early contacts with the Bushmen and of the gradual awakening of interest in them.

Section 2 lists a number of general works as well as popular works. Each publication in this section covers more than one, sometimes many, aspects of the San or Bushmen.

The remaining six sections deal with specific facets; many of the items listed here are not books but articles that have been published in scientific and other periodicals or journals. The aspects covered are:

Section 4 Ecology and Survival, Demography, Social Organisation

Section 5 Biological Anthropology, including Medical Aspects

Section 6 Psychology and Ethology
